GENERAL BUSINESS

Car Inc Meeting

Fundraising

Venue

Cost of the current venue is prohibitive. Trevor has found an alternative venue at the Raceview Shopping Centre. It holds about 14 people, has a kitchen for coffee facilities and ample parking. It is available to use for free thanks to a local Councillor who has granted us permission. There was some discussion of rotating meetings between member houses, however group decided that it was important to have a home base. Trevor to confirm that Raceview premises are suitable and available. Next meeting will still be at the Uniting Church and a decision will be made then.

Membership Fee Structure

It was proposed that the fee structure of MCGI be changed at the next AGM (August 2012) which would reward members who interact with the club during the year. Whilst the fees cannot be changed until then, it was agreed to include the proposal in the minutes to give all members an opportunity to receive the reduced fees next year. The proposal will be to increase the MCGI membership quite substantially – e.g. maybe \$50 – but any member that has attended or participated in at least 3 events or meetings in the previous 12 months (ie from August 2011) will receive a large discount e.g. 40% therefore bringing the fee back to an amount similar to that currently paid by all members. Any current member who has not been to three meetings or events between August 2011 and August 2012 will be required to pay the new fee. The other advantage of this new fee structure will be that new members will pay the full price, but will have the opportunity to receive the reduced amount in their second year if they become active and participatory members of the club in the following 12 months.
